- You will learn to conduct **economic and financial analyses**, which allow the assessment of a company's financial health.
- You will gain knowledge about **financial risk assessment and management**.
- You will have the opportunity to apply for **exemption from ACCA exams (F1-F4)**, which accelerates earning an international accounting certificate.

## Work opportunities

- You will find employment as an **independent accountant**, handling accounting for companies and institutions.
- Work in **legal and tax offices**, assisting clients with tax and financial matters.
- Take up a position in **accounting offices**, providing bookkeeping services for various enterprises.
- Work as an **internal auditor**. Ensure procedures comply with regulations, identify risks, and support the improvement of management processes within the organisation.
- Work as a **tax adviser**. Help companies optimise their tax burden and interpret and apply tax regulations.
- Develop as a **controlling specialist**. Support corporate financial management by creating cost optimisation and reporting strategies.

## Internships and practical training

Student internships are an important part of the study program. Students of bachelor's and long-cycle master's studies complete 960 hours of internships (24 weeks), gaining professional experience. If you work in a profession related to your field of study, you can have your internship credited based on your employment. During your studies, you also have the opportunity to take a paid internship. Internship programs are designed by cooperating employers, tailoring requirements to specific positions, which helps you take your first professional steps.

## Study completion requirements

You develop your final-year project as part of a team, addressing a practical or theoretical problem related to your field of study. By reviewing the literature and conducting your own analyses, you work on an original solution to the problem. Everything you learn during your studies enables you to produce a professional project based on real data and practical activities. To obtain a bachelor's degree, you must defend this project before an examination board. You set the direction of your project!
