Internships and practical training

Professional internships are an important part of the study program. Master's students complete 480 hours of internship throughout their studies, gaining professional experience. If you work in a field related to your program, you may have the internship credited based on your employment. During your studies, you also have the opportunity to take part in a paid internship. Internship programs are prepared by partner employers, who tailor their requirements to specific positions, helping you take your first professional steps.

Study completion requirements

Master's studies conclude with the preparation and defense of a master's thesis. Throughout the program, the completion of individual courses is based on projects, presentations, and written or oral exams. The entire process is practical in nature and focused on developing professional competencies.
