Scholars, researchers & students interested to take an active part in the congress are asked to send their **abstracts not exceeding 200 words and a bio-note with maximum 150 words**, to the address: <ecosemiotic.festival@gmail.com>. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed and accepted as **ordinary papers (30 min.)**, or **master lectures (45 min.)**. Abstracts accepted for July of 2020 are still valid for the September 2021 rescheduled congress.

Facing the pandemic situation, the organizers offer three opportunities of participation: (1) **registration for online participation** with a publication opportunity = **135,00 PLN** (= ca 30 EUR) (2) **registration for the inclusion into the program with an online presentation** and publication opportunity = **315,00 PLN** (= ca 70 EUR); (3) **registration for the inclusion into the one-day program** (including privileges of online participation on remaining days) **with a personal presentation** and publication opportunity = **315,00 PLN** (= ca 70 EUR); & **private participation** (also for accompanying persons) in social packages (refreshments and excursions) during all days of the congress = **800,00 PLN** (= ca 180 EUR) **paid onsite**. The fee with the note – “**Eco-Communicology, participant’s name, private or institutional address & the amount paid in PLN**” – should be transferred to the account of The Polish Academy of Sciences Botanical Garden Center for Biological Diversity Conservation in Powsin.
